- 1. The <u>Coronavirus Act 2020, Part 1, Section 78</u> allows for Parish Councils to hold Virtual Meetings online instead of meetings in person until 6th May 2021.
- 2. The Council have a <u>legal obligation</u> to elect the Chair annually in May. If the Annual Meeting is held online after 6th May, there may be challenge regarding the legality of any decisions taken at the meeting.
- 3. <u>Lockdown restrictions</u> on meeting indoors continue until 21st June when more than one family may meet in a public place. This means the earliest the council can meet in person is 21st June. Therefore no meetings can take place between 7th May and 21st June, either in person or online unless legislation changes.
- 4. The Annual Governance & Accountability Return (AGAR) must to be submitted to the external Auditors by latest 1st July 2021 and therefore the Annual Accounts will need to be approved before that date. (No extension has been granted this year).
- 5. The Annual Audit will be undertaken on Tuesday 27th April, where the AGAR will be signed by the Auditor. In theory, the Agenda for the May meeting can be sent on Thursday 29th April giving three clear working days notice for Tuesday 4th May. (Saturday is included.)
