Current draft (October 2021):

Our vision for Nether Wallop in 2031 is for an active, safe, and welcoming community, made sustainable through appropriate responses to economic, digital, and climactic changes. This plan seeks to preserve and enhance the neighbourhood's unique characteristics, in particular the cluster of heritage buildings nestled within a unique landscape.

This unique landscape is based around the Wallop Brook and the surrounding area is characterised by small-scale patchworks of settlements, small holdings, riverside meadow, pastures, and woodland. Together, these distinct landscape types support economically active farming community and outstanding wildlife populations.
